ACADEMIC ASPECTS:

- To extend OBE for PG programmes from the AY 2021-22.
- To extend credit transfer from SWAYAM / NPTEL against all Elective Courses.
- To introduce a course on life skills (Jeevan Kaushal) to all final year students under the aegis of UGC quality mandate.
- To introduce ADD-ON courses, Self-Learning courses and many more value added courses.
- To encourage departments to offer at least one inter-disciplinary course and one multi-disciplinary course.
- To promote internship training programmes for students. In this connection, the departments shall consider collaboration with industry.
- To prepare manual of attainment for calculating course / programme outcomes under OBE.

- To have a common examination pattern for all PG programmes.

- To introduce cloud based mark entry system for OBE pattern.

STUDENT SUPPORT:

- To develop student portal in the college website enabling the students to interact with the mentors / college administration, submit feedback and register grievances.
- To conduct Student Induction Programme (SIP) through online mode.
- To conduct capacity building and skill enhancement programmes for students.
- To offer guidance / coaching for competitive exams and career counselling.
- To conduct campus placement drives.
- To subscribe to NDLI club towards promotion of Digital Library access to students.
- To setup a co-operative store to be run by students.
- To constitute a Divyangjan Welfare Committee and also to conduct special programmes for the benefit of Divyanjan students.

PROMOTION OF RESEARCH:

- To review research policy and suggest amendments.
- To create research ID's for all the faculty members of the College in recognized platforms like Google Scholar, Vidwan, Web of Science, Scopus and ORCID.
- To create awareness among the faculty members in tapping funds (Research Projects) from various funding agencies.
