

## 6. COLLEGE ANNUAL REPORT (2019-20)

### Academics & related activities:

Around 550 students have been admitted and 400 graduates are outgoing this year. The college has a total strength of 1341 in the aided stream.

The Pass percentages in various courses are more than 80 with M.Sc(Maths) 95%, B.Sc.,(Maths) 94% , M.A.,(Eng. Litt) 94%and M.Sc.,(Bot) 92%. Systematic teaching, regularized continuous internal assessment(CIA) and necessary remedial teaching have enabled the institution to achieve good results.

### New initiatives:

In order to use effectively the Library facilities new Updated software for library that can be accessed by students through their mobile is installed this year. COE office is completely digitalized and students can now submit their application and payments online. New student portal for online access of the resources and to have complete online transaction with the institution is in pipeline. Four lane synthetic tennis court is under construction and that is a new milestone in the history of our college. Another new playground is built behind the DJ block and with this ours is the lone college in the city with seven playgrounds and of which three are exclusive cricket grounds. At this juncture, the entire faculty thanks the management for their financial and moral support for all the new initiatives.

### Regular Activities:

Monthly Students council meetings are conducted for students to express their grievances to the administration. Monthly meetings of College council, Heads of the Department are conducted to discuss academic and non-academic activities to realize the goals of the institution. Feedback registered by the students is circulated to the faculty to know their strength and weakness and to improve their academic role. The college administration also shows keen interest in the suggestions forwarded by the students and to maintain the legacy of the Madura college having concern over its major stake holders 'Students'.
