Academics& related activities

Around 550 students have been admitted and 400 graduates are outgoing this year. The college has a total strength of 1403 in the aided stream. The College offer 7 UG, 9 PG and Ph.D., programmes in the Aided Stream.

During the pandemic period as per the govt. direction both CIA and external semester examinations were conducted using an indigenous developed software tool. . The Pass percentages in various courses are more than 95%. Well-Planned teaching through online mode and proper interaction using multimedia tools with students during pandemic period have enabled the institution to achieve good results.

The Campus is now wi-fi enabled with controlled access to internet contents (content restrictions). In addition to the NLIST facility DELNET- a data base for inter library lending is added as a new feature. Self-issue provision for student is in pipe line.

New Initiatives – Infra-Structure Developments

Madura College Tennis Academy : *A flood lightt synthetic Tennis court to conduct international level matches has been constructed in which two international sub-junior and junior level matches were conducted. In order to serve locals of Madurai a Tennis Camp for 15 days was conducted.*

Solar Power Plant : *As a Green initiatives, 25 KW Solar Power Plant facility has been established on the terrace of KBR Block. This facility meets out almost 25% of power requirement of SF wing.*

Miyawaki forests : *The Management of The Madura College jointly with Rotary Club (West) have planted 5500 samples of 110 varieties. The forest will be spread out on an area of one acre adjacent to TVS Block and act as green lung for the region. It will help in promoting the local biodiversity. Student engagement is also an important aspect of this project as workshops will be conducted to train them on soil amendment and the Miyawaki method of plantation. The maintenance and monitoring of the forest will also be done by the students and college staff. At this juncture, the entire faculty thanks the management for their financial and moral support for all the new initiatives.*
