*Esteemed Chief Guest of the day Dr.Sridharan Subramanian, Respected President, Vice-President, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, Directors, Members of the MCB, Dean(Admin), Dean(Academics), Dean (P&D), COE, Deputy COEs, HoDs, faculty, administrative and support staff, retired faculty, parents, alumnae and my dear students, it gives me immense pleasure to present the Annual Report on the activities of this great institution during the Academic Year 2022-23.*

*I begin the annual report by felicitating our retiring non-teaching staff Mr. C. Jeyachandran. He will be remembered for his service in the Physics Laboratory and later in office. We would like to register our sincere thanks to him and may the almighty bless him with a peaceful, happy and healthy retired life!*

### **Academics& related activities**

*Around 530 students have been admitted and 380 graduates are outgoing this year. The college has a total strength of 1350 in the aided stream.*

*Academic year 2022-23 is a full-fledged one with classes conducted fully in off-line mode after the pandemic period. The college (the management & staff) tirelessly worked to submit SSR (self-study report) to NAAC for the 4<sup>th</sup> cycle of accreditation. The college is presently in the 'A'-grade. As many as 1.5 lakh pages of reports on the activities of the college from 2017-22 were submitted and the college is awaiting for the visit of peer team in the month of June and we hope to improve our present score. At this juncture, I must thank Prof. S. Sivaramakrishnan and Dr. I. Sahul Hamid for the meticulous planning and hard work rendered in the submission of SSR. The contributions of NAAC office clerks are praise worthy.*

### **New initiatives-Academic Activities**

*Two of our PG departments, viz., Commerce and English have been upgraded to PG and Centre for Research by the Madurai Kamaraj University and with this all the PG Depts except the dept. of statistics(started in 2019) are now approved Centres for Research.*

*The Campus is now wi-fi enabled with controlled access to internet contents (content restrictions). In addition to the NLIST facility DELNET- a data base for inter library lending as a new feature, Divyangjan Point is added to the library, for physically challenged students to access audio-lecture, audio-books etc., Students of 2022-23 are the first outcome-based education batch.*

*The college introduced inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary courses in the final year of UG and PG curriculum respectively, which is a new and novel initiative in our curriculum design. 2022-23 pass-out UG graduates will also get their attainment of the aimed outcome. The college has developed its own attainment modalities and it is a pioneering step in our evaluation process.*

*The Madura College became an Associate Member of the ICT Academy till 14-12-2025. Dr. R. Vennila, Dr. S. Sureshkannan and Prof. J. Gayathri attended 3 days FDP program on “Stress Management.*

### **New Initiatives – Infra-Structure Developments**

**College Health Centre:** *The college now has a healthcare Centre available with a full-time qualified nurse. A doctor on call has been provided to our students. Further facilities are provided through e-sanjeevani for online consultation, free of cost. Arrangements have been made to provide medicines free of charge to students after consultation.*

**Solar Power Plant:** *As a continuous green initiative, two more 25 KW Solar Power Plant facilities have been added on the terrace of KBR Block. This facility meets more than 50% of power requirement of SF wing.*

**Vermi compost pits:** *To promote the local biodiversity and to act as a green lung for the region the college has planted 5500 samples of 110 varieties as Miyawaki forests. A flower garden is also formed near the canteen. To promote the growth of plants and trees in the campus and to start a small entrepreneurial activity, the college has constructed two vermicompost pits. Nutrient-rich earth-worm manure is prepared from these pits. Going forward, the college has planned to market the excess manure over the internal usage.*

**Apiculture unit:** *It is a known fact that pollen exchange promotes plant reproduction and hence its population indirectly. To create awareness among students on this important activity and to promote entrepreneurial activities in the campus, three apiculture units are placed recently in the Miyawaki forests as a piloting project and beehives are expected to be formed yielding honey.*

**Glass House or Green House:** *Greenhouse, also called Glasshouse, is a building designed for the protection of tender or out-of-season plants against the excessive cold or heat. Plants that are grown in pots for the project purposes are securely maintained inside the glass house. It has a separate chamber, made-up of bamboo sticks, for the cultivation of mushrooms.*

**Computer Facilities:** *In order to meet the growing demand for the computer facilities as with Internet access in the teaching-learning process, every department has been provided with a minimum of four computers and a dedicated internet facility. The facilities are intended for the exclusive use of students.*

## Regular Activities

*Students Council meetings are conducted once a month for students to express their grievances/suggestions to the administration. Monthly meetings of College council, Heads of the Department are conducted to discuss academic and non-academic activities to realize the goals of the institution. Feedbacks registered by the students are circulated to the faculty to know their strengths and weakness and to improve their academic role. The college administration also shows keen interest in the suggestions forwarded by the students and to maintain the legacy of the Madura college having concern over its major stakeholders, 'Students'. Same is the importance given to feedback from alumni and parents.*
