## POLICY FOR DIVYANGJAN WELFARE

The Madura College aims to create an atmosphere where all students are treated equally without any discrimination. At this end, our college is committed to facilitate and bridge the needs of differently abled students to have the same opportunities as everyone else.

Specific number of seats will be reserved in Admission for differently abled students as per the reservation policy of the state government. The college has decided that no fee shall be payable by differently abled students including tuition fee, exam fee and special fee.


While the college has restricted the use of automobiles in the college campus, such restriction is not applicable to modes of transportation for differently abled students. The college has taken efforts to provide facilities like ramp and differently abled friendly toilets in certain buildings. The college would take efforts to extend similar facilities in all the buildings.

The college library has been enabled with screen reading software to enable students with visual challenges to learn from open educational resources and e-resources.

Differently abled students would be provided with additional time / scribe as the case may be as decided by the college from time to time.

Divyangjan welfare committee would be created to address the special needs of divyangjan students and to organize special programmes to equip them to the needs of the job market.
