Academics & related activities

This year, 511 students have been admitted, and 456 students have graduated. The college currently maintains a total enrollment of 1,214 students in the aided stream.

Starting from the academic year 2026-27, the college plans to introduce new programs, including B.Com. Corporate Secretaryship, B.Sc. Data Science, M.Sc. Hospital Administration, and an additional section for B.Com (CA). The Commission has conducted a visit to the college, and we are now awaiting approval from MKU.

New Initiatives – Infra-Structure Developments

Two state-of-the-art smart classrooms have been newly constructed: one in the Platinum Jubilee Block, Room F1, and another in the Sri Narasimhachariar & Smt. Rangammal Block, Room F07.
